## Measles Vaccination

[MMR vaccination is available at any age. The NHS](#) have launched a [catch-up campaign](#) for missed MMR vaccines. The NHS will contact all parents of children aged 6 to 11 as part of this, encouraging MMR uptake. If children (and young adults) have missed their vaccinations in the past, it is important for them to have the vaccine now, especially in light of recent cases/outbreaks in other parts of England. Children usually have the first dose of the MMR vaccine at 1 year-old and the second dose at 3 years and 4 months. A version of MMR is available which does not contain pork ingredients. There have been no known cases within the school.


