

Maths	This term we are reading...
<p>Time, shape and statistics (Year 3) Shape, statistics and position and direction (Year 4)</p>	
Computing	
<p>In this unit the children will develop their understanding of their programming skills. This unit looks at repetition and loops within programming. Pupils will create programs by planning, modifying, and testing commands to create shapes and patterns. They will use Logo, a text-based programming language.</p>	
Art	Science
<p>For Art this term we are going to be doing printing. We will be looking at a variety of artwork using the print techniques. The children will create a printing block and practise using it and look at repetitive patterns and what impact this has. The children will be creating a printing block inspired by our topic of Ancient Egyptians and be using two different colours in the prints.</p>	<p>The enquiry question for this term is ‘How have humans impacted on the environment?’ and it will involve the children learning about different habitats and this will be enhanced by the trips the different year groups will be going on this term. We will be observing and classifying animals and plants into groups based upon their characteristics. We will learn about classification keys and create and test our own key. Children will consider ways in which animals living in environments are affected by human behaviour, then suggest ways in which we can help protect and sustain habitats.</p>

Term: Summer Term 2

<p>This will continue to be on a Monday and Tuesday, please ensure kit is in school from Monday each week. On Monday Year 3 and 4 children will be doing dance. On Tuesday the children will be doing outdoor and adventurous activities with Coach Abbie.</p>	<p>Narnia will be exploring the question ‘Where do we belong?’ in RE. Children will learn that a number of external factors help shape our identity and the ways that they can express their identity. Children will think about what ‘diversity’ means (in terms of the UK population). They will learn some of the responsibilities linked with being part of a global community.</p>
Music	French
<p>‘Opening night’ is theme for music this term and the children will learn new songs and the children will have the opportunity to perform the songs to each other.</p>	<p>In French this term the children will be looking about the topic of ‘habitats’.</p>
History	Big Bang
<p>The enquiry question for this term is ‘What have we learnt from the ancient Egyptians?’ and will involve the children studying about the three farming seasons which link to the river Nile. The children will learn about the mummification process and look at famous Egyptian King. They will finish off with looking at why the pharaohs were buried in tombs.</p>	<p>This terms big bang will be linked to our Egyptian topic where we will have an Egyptian afternoon. We will be creating a mask and coffin for an Egyptian king or queen. Also, we will be making some Egyptian bread.</p>
PSHE	
<p>This term’s learning will focus on children ‘Changing Me’ and we will teach the children all about how humans will change as they get older and how this is the same for all living creatures. The children will learn the correct name for different body parts and how our bodies may change as we grow up. They learn the importance of knowing where it is appropriate to be touched and where it is not.</p>
