



Computing	
<p>During this term, the children will be exploring photography and how technology can be used to change aspects of photos whilst they are being taken as well as afterwards.</p>	
Art	
<p>The children will be using clay and natural materials to create pieces of art which incorporate different textures, inspired by the work of artist Andrew Goldsworthy.</p>	
PE	
<p>Our PE sessions will continue to be on a Tuesday and Wednesday. During Tuesday's lessons, the children will be taught by Coach Abi from Carres Grammar and will be improving their sending and receiving skills in Golf. On a Wednesday, we will do athletics as a class. Please ensure children have PE kits in school all week; in case the timetable needs to change.</p>	
Music	
<p>This term in music, the unit is called '<b>Having Fun with Improvisation</b>'. Children will listen to songs and have the opportunity to improvise instrumental parts as well as changing some lyrics.</p>	
Geography	Science
<p>The enquiry question for this term is '<b>How do we all fit on Earth?</b>' and the children will explore the shape of the earth, the continents and oceans, the equator and hemispheres, the North and South Poles as well as finding the UK on a globe and map of the Earth.</p>	<p>The enquiry question for this term is '<b>Where do I belong in the animal kingdom?</b>' and the children will explore the animal kingdom by learning how to sort animals into different groups, including: mammals, reptiles, fish etc.</p>

For our Big Bang, the children will spend some time exploring the Earth! They will study maps of the Earth as well as attempting to make some 3D globes of the planet and see if they can identify where we live in the United Kingdom!
