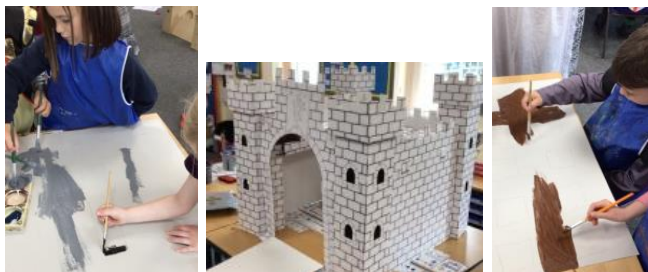

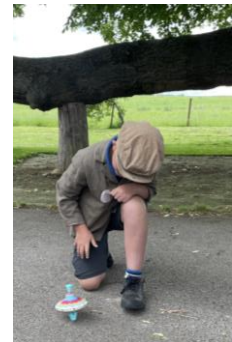


Hogwarts Victorian School Experience

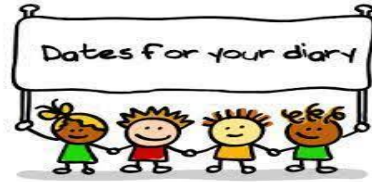
