**Key Stage One SATs**

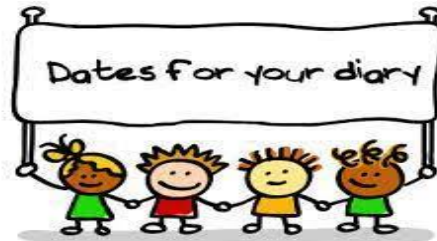

### TTRock Stars

Knowing times table facts is fundamental to your child's success in maths.



Children are expected to recall the times table facts to 12x12 by the end of Year 4. This helps them solve long multiplication problems as well as make links to fractions and recall division facts fluently. We subscribe to Times Table Rock Stars for each pupil at Caythorpe, to engage them in a fun way to learn their multiplication facts.

All pupils from Year 2 to 6 have a username and password to access the games. Playing in the "Garage" and "Arena" areas, children will practise times tables which have been set for individual pupils. Children also have great fun with their rock star, using coins earn to buy rock outfits and accessories from the rock shop.

To increase pupil motivation, we have introduced certificates for most coins earned and most time engaged for each class to be awarded as part of our celebration assembly on Fridays.
