*"More opportunities to come into school"*

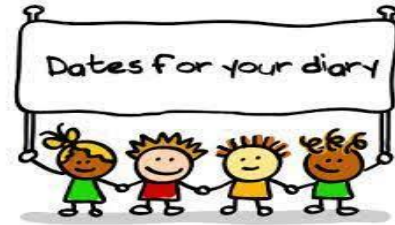
As above, we were not able to welcome visitors into the school and Omicron put a hold on a few events - however we can't wait to welcome you all back in for reading days and special events.



## Year 4 Multiplication Check

Is your child in Year 4? If so, your child will be participating in the multiplication tables check in June. The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help us to identify if your child may need additional support. The check has been designed so that it is inclusive and accessible to as many children as possible, including those with special educational needs or disability (SEND) or English as an additional language (EAL). However, there may be some circumstances in which it will not be appropriate for a pupil to take the check, even when using suitable access arrangements. If you have any concerns about your child accessing the check, you should discuss this with Mr Knight.

In our end of year reports we will share your child's score with you, as with all national curriculum assessments. There is no pass mark for the check. All children can practise their times tables using the [Times Table Rock Stars](#) online platform. If you need a reminder of your login and password, please ask your class teacher.
