The School Council have decided to support the worthy cause of Children in Need this year.

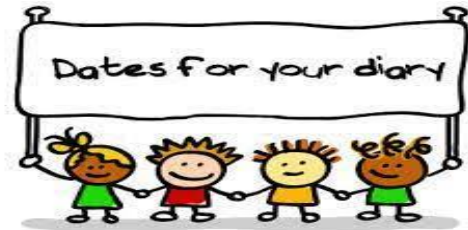
There will be a British Bake Off competition.

Ask Dan Anything - Online Safety Q and A for Primary Parents 6th December 6pm-7:30pm

In the Keeping Safe Online Survey of 2023 Lincolnshire Children who reported having **less parental supervision online** were **more likely to report being bullied online**, effective parental/guardian supervision of a child's online activity reduced the risk of children being bullied online by up to 39%. The online space can feel overwhelming with new apps and trends, it can be hard to keep up! We want to give you the information and tools to help you feel confident enough to protect your children and young people from online harm.
